ABOUT PCFF

The Parents Circle-Families Forum (PCFF) is an organization of more than 600 Israeli and Palestinian bereaved families. Since its establishment, the members - all of whom have lost a family member to the conflict - have undertaken a joint effort in the midst of ongoing violence to transform their incredible loss and pain into a catalyst for reconciliation and peace. PCFF's members educate Israelis and Palestinians about their personal cost of the conflict in both societies and through their personal stories in the hope of building a grassroots constituency of Palestinians and Israelis committed to ending the violence between societies.

Our generous contribution has gone towards the funding of several influential PCFF programs including dialogue meetings. PCFF's Dialogue meetings reach over 7,000 people with 78% of attendees reporting an increased belief in the possibility of peace. With our financial support, PCFF has been able to continue as well as expand these programs in order to inspire new individuals to take part in reconciliation activities.



THE MAIA PROJECT

The MAIA project works to bring clean water to the children of Palestine. This project provides relief from the major public health crisis posed by drinking water that is contaminated by minerals, sewage and agricultural and industrial chemicals.

Access to clean water is one the most essential aspects in life. Without it, nothing else can be achieved. With our generous contribution to the Maia project, we have been able to install two new water purification and desalination units in Rimal Preparatory Co-Ed School and Rimal Preparatory Boys School in Gaza. This year alone, we have been able to provide safe clean drinking water to over 3,420 students, teachers and staff.
